
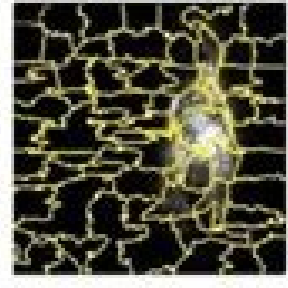
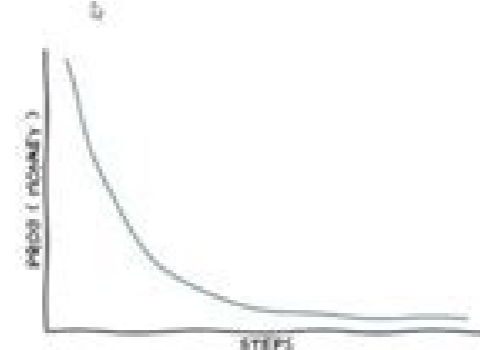
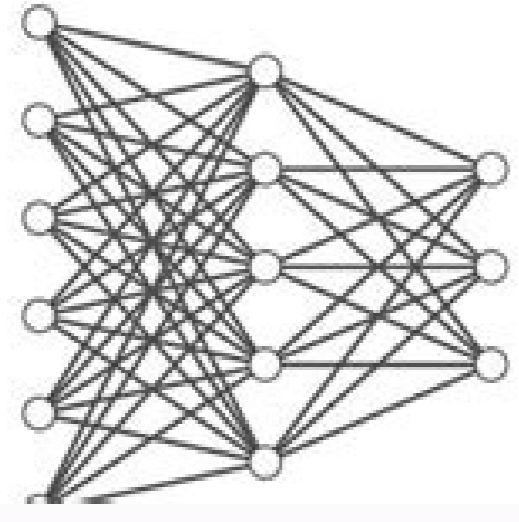

Plastic surgery was invented following World War I. This is much shorter than Chandler and a perfect introductory work that will explain the conflict very well. The war broke out a month later when Austria-Hungary declared war on Serbia. By Barry Strauss. The maps may look fairly dull at first sight (using a limited palette), but they really aren't! This classic work covers the leading commanders in Napoleon's army: the Marshals. This is a guide to all the weapons you'll come across in other texts, and what impact they had on the battles. Of course, the traditional interpretation is that of Homer supplemented by other minor or later works. A horse would have been an appropriate gift to leave outside Troy—an admission of defeat in a sense. Unfortunately, it's gone out of print since I bought mine and can be very expensive. Strauss, in opposition to the conventional wisdom, believes it may well have existed even if later generations misunderstood its function. Conversely, tales of looting the Trojan countryside, attacking Troy's allies, and selling prisoners and hostages as slaves fit contemporary norms. Due to the interest one profound event in Napoleon's life, we have a completely separate selection of literature dedicated just to the Battle of Waterloo. This all-time literary classic is set in Russia during the Napoleonic Wars, mostly in 1812. A solid military narrative of the whole Napoleonic Wars is accompanied by a massive range of detailed maps, showing campaigns, battles and troop movements. This is a real favorite of mine: a guide to how units moved, operated and were formed during the wars, by a man who's long been a favorite of wargamers. As for Homer's veracity, Strauss finds his narrative remarkably consistent with what we now know about civilization in 1200 B.C. Whether one considers Strauss' findings a major reinterpretation, a minor adjustment, or a confirmation of Homer is a question of half-empty or half-full. It can also be had very cheaply, but that's no reflection on the writing, and don't feel you have to 'go long' with Austin, as this is top class stuff.
